EDITORIAL NOTE

This series of indexes of various Fantasy Publications is designed especially to cover the smaller, short-lived and lesser-known fantasy publications. It may also include occasionally some periodical which is not strictly fantasy, but which contains stories by well-known fantasy writers. For example, such magazines as "GOLDEN FLEECE", "ORIENTAL STORIES," and "MAGIC CARPET."

"The IMAG.-INDEX", the various "YEAR BOOKS", etc., indexed and classified the stories of the fantasy publications. Their method was to list the contents of a magazine, issue by issue. The method used in this series is to list the Authors in alphabetical order, placing under each author a list of their stories, classified as to title, date, and length: (whether short story, novelette, novel, or serial.) Also, a brief history and description of each magazine precedes each index. My own files of the science fiction magazines published in the United States is complete. The magazines have been indexed from my own files over a period of years. If anything has been overlooked, or if mistakes are found please notify us so that we can make corrections:

"FAMOUS FANTASTIC MYSTERIES" was begun by the Frank A. Munsey Company in 1939 as a reprint agency for the old classics of Fantasy from AUGUSTI, ALL-STORY, CAVALIER, and other "Munsey" publications. With the March 1943 issue, All-Fiction Field, Inc. became the publishers. The policy was changed to reprinting outstanding fantastic tales that had appeared only in book form.

# Science — Fiction

"SCIENCE FICTION" was edited by Charles D. Horning, cost 15¢ per copy, had about 130 pages and was published irregularly. The dates of the various issues are as follows; 1939—March, June, August, October, and December.

1940—March, June, October

1941—January, March, June, September.

After September 1941, SCIENCE FICTION was combined with FUTURE FICTION.

In April 1943 the title once more became SCIENCE FICTION. It appeared for one more issue, July 1943, and then ceased publication. (These last two issues are indexed along with FUTURE combined with SCIENCEFICTION.)


