Moved, 11/8/67, that the Phil Bridges booklet recently distributed to the Directors be reprinted and distributed as an NFFF Fandbook, printing expenses not to exceed \$30. This is now being voted on.

Moved, 11/8/67, that the NFFF support the publication of the "Meskys-Trimble" BOK ARTFOLIO by defraying half of the publishing costs, \$35, on the understanding that NFFF members will be able to buy the Artfolio at \$2.00, and that any profits from the sale of the folio go into worthy funds for the benefit of fandom. STAR TREK MAY NOT OUTLIVE THIS SEASON

Gene Roddenberry of STAR TREK says that so far there has been no word of renewing the program for next season, and that it is highly likely the show will die unless something is done. Gene called Bjo Trimble (because she previously promised to publish a one-shot about the show if any need came up), and Bjo has sent out a notice asking for material about how to solve the problem of survival for this problem, probably to be published just after Christmas. She also needs addresses of interested people. Her address is 243 Santa Rosa Ave., Oakland, Calif. 94610.

January is the time to pick up the option, so this does not give interested people much time to act. You can write to advertisers, NBC or, through Roddenberry (at 780 N. Gower, Hollywood, Calif. 90038) to stars of the program. I suggest you write several, perhaps through local channels. If you have ideas how to make a campaign successful send them on, too; also if you belong to club or groups of fans formed around STAR TREK, send the information (including addresses of all members and officers you know) to Bjo, so she can send a copy of the one-shot publication. Tell information on any fanclubs such as dues, publications and the like, too. Remember, a campaign to save the program worked before and it was because of enthusiastic effort of lots of people--and so tell your friends to help if you want the program to survive.

Gene said the move to Friday night time slot had almost killed the show; the lively young-minded people who dig the show are also active enough to be "out" on Friday nights. Also, the Neilson ratings have been low on the show, although informal and "unofficial" polls by magazines have placed it very high on their lists. Now is the time to write NBC, etc. to help.

This column is something of a summary, of the information given in personal letters over the past few months. Information Bureau questions have fallen off recently, perhaps because of the infrequent publication of this column. This need not be a barrier, since questions are answered promptly when asked (within a few weeks) by postcard or letter. Any member wanting some information on science fiction, fantasy, fandom or the N3F (those four subjects only) may write me direct, and I will answer to the best of my ability.

WALTER WENTZ wanted some addresses of old-time Merrittophiles -- most of which I couldn't supply. He is presently engaged in finishing up the research for a second edition of the Merritt biblio. Anyone having a copy of the Hearst American Weekly newspaper Sunday section for Sep. 23, 1923, containing W. Fenimore's "Pool of the Stone God" would make Walt happy by lending it for copying, or contacting him. Apparently "Fenimore" is a pen-name of Merritt himself.

DAVE CANTRELL legally exceeded the five-question limit by writing twice. He asked whether the now-defunct Warhoon was a Burroughs fanzine. No, it was not, though the name would seem to indicate this. It was largely a serious-discussion zine, of the intellectual type. He asks about paperback collections of Lovecraft. Because of Lovecraft's stories appearing in Arkham House editions pretty exclusively, there haven't been many paperback editions. The Dunwich Horror, Bartholomew House, 1945; The Weird Shadow Over Innsmouth, 1944; and The Lurking Fear, Avon, 1947 were all there were until recently, when Lancer brought out The Color Out of Space; Ballantine, The Survivor, and Belmont, The Case of Charles Dexter Ward.

Dave asks, re the N3F, "What is the Kaymar Award?" The Kaymar Award is a very generous and continuous annual gift to the N3F by K. Martin Carlson. It rewards achievement by some N3F member over a long period of time, and is not for talent, but for work, in the interests of the club. Carlson has contributed books, a cash award, a certificate, paid-up memberships, etc., and also has charge of the method of selection of winners, by a committee. And, "How long has Janie Lamb been Secretary and/or Treasurer of the N3F?" Janie has been Secretary since 1953, and Treasurer since 1955, the two offices having been re-combined then, as they were at first, when the N3F started.

And finally, Dave asks, "What fanzines can you get for a letter of comment? What fanzines can't you get? But you can't write a letter of comment without seeing the fanzine first. Send for a copy, paying the small sum mentioned (there are some even free for the asking) and then comment on it...you can keep this up as long as you want without spending another cent, most of the time. Or join the New Fanzine Appreciation Society, and trusting faneds may send you their zines, as long as you do your part after you get them, by commenting, contributing, or subscribing.

Oops--left out something. Dave Cantrell wanted to know about sequels to Eric Rucker Eddison's "Worm Ouroboros" ("Mistress of Mistresses" is the only actual sequel), and if there was a fan club for Eddison as well as C.S. Lewis, George McDonald or Charles Williams. Nothing organized that I know of, but there are many fans of Eddison as well as of C.S. Lewis's "Narnia" series.

ROY TACKETT liked Wilson Tucker's "The Long Loud Silence" and says, "Somewhere I have heard that Tucker actually wrote two endings to the book and that both of them have been published in variant editions." Bob Tucker is a member of N3F, so instead of answering this (or admitting I don't know the answer) why not invite Bob to write an article for TNFF, entitled "Why I wrote 'Long Loud Silence' the way I did?" Why should FAPA and Yandro get all the gravy?

///INFORMATION BUREAU, continued... A letter from STEVE SUMMERS asks about a pamphlet that tells the activities and purposes of various bureaus in the N3F. Unfortunately, such a pamphlet does not exist, but would be very useful to new members, and an effort will be made to compile and publish one soon.

Yet another question about the Hugo Awards, from SHERRY D. HALE. It's time to update and reprint the Handbook, "Some Historical Facts About SF Fandom", which was published by the N3F in 1962, and give such facts as the Hugo Awards, International Fantasy Awards, dates of conventions, TAFT winners, etc. When this is updated and published it should include 1967 facts, with some new things such as the Nebula Awards. Don't ask for it yet; we've got to do it first! (though I have all the facts needed, somewhere).

PIERCE asks several questions about various authors which involve opinion rather than information, which I couldn't answer very well, but did the best I could. When you send in questions not only make them brief and to the point, but make it possible for me to make brief answers... someone (not John) asked "Send me all the information you have about fandom, the NFFF, fanzines, genzines, etc." Even the Fancyclopedia wouldn't compare with the letter I'd have to write with the answer to that one.

PAUL WILLIS wanted to know if there was a checklist to the illustrations for Clark Ashton Smith's stories. I doubt this, but some day there may be a list of the artists for all the illustrations in the magazines -- this may be included in some really complete magazine index, on the model of Al Lewis's annual editions (1961-62-63).

ROBERT WIL-

LINGHAM asked what bureaus of the N3F published their own zines. At present, only the Collectors' Bureau and the Games Bureau, though there have been others in the past.

And that's all they wrote...




