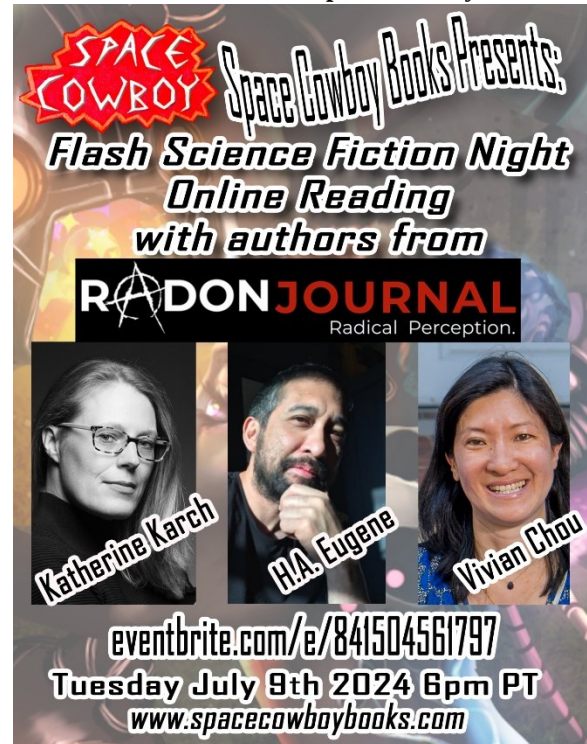

**In Personal News:**

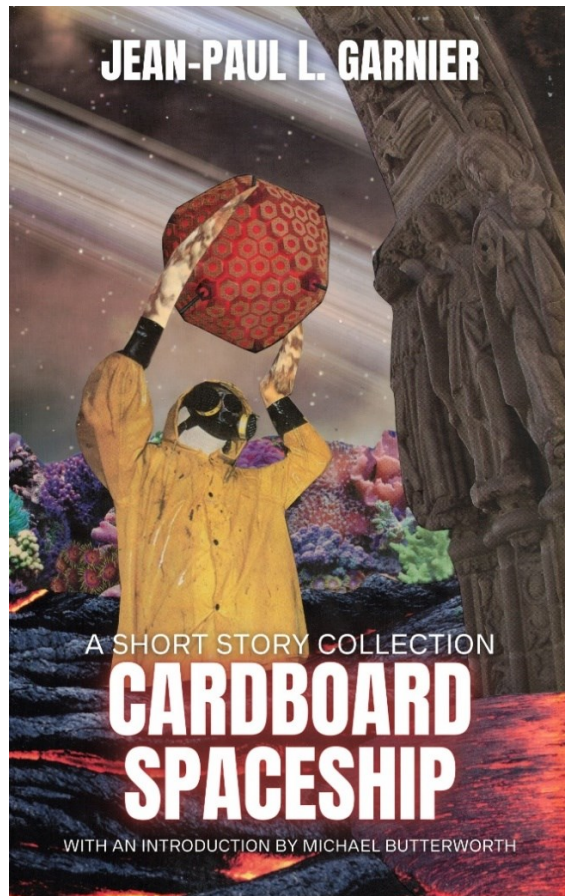
